Aluminium Industry Finding Aid

British Aluminium Co Ltd

In June 1942, British Aluminium Co acting as agents for the Ministry of Aircraft Production was assigned the task of constructing a plant principally to produce aircraft alloy and sheet for the military aircraft programme. The result was the British Aluminium Plant at Bainsford which was officially opened in June 1944. After the war ended British Aluminium took over sole ownership of the plant and, although the plant continued to supply the aircraft industry, aluminium sheet and alloy was also manufactured for more general purposes.

In the 1970s British Aluminium formed ties with Tube Investment in the UK and Reynolds Metals in the USA. In 1983 British Aluminium merged with Alcan Aluminium (UK) to form British Alcan. After several years of rationalisation across the company it was decided to close the Hot Rolling Plant and the South Finishing Dept. at the Falkirk Plant. This led to the loss of 700 staff. Increased modernisation led to further decreases in staff over the years and by the time the plant eventually closed in 2005 there were only 150 employees remaining.
