##### **Alexander, W. & Co (Coachbuilders) Ltd**

Originally part of Walter Alexander & Sons, (formed in 1924), the bodybuilding works were sold to a new company, Walter Alexander & Co (Coachbuilders) in 1949, prior to the acquisition of the parent company by the British Transport Commission as part of bus nationalisation.

##### **Thomson T-Line Caravans Ltd**

Thomson T-Line Caravans Ltd originated in Skaithmuir Mill in 1908. The company moved to Carronshore in 1931 and in 1932 was incorporated as Thomson Caravans Ltd. It was registered as Thomson T-Line (Homes) Ltd, Edinburgh. The Company was incorporated in 1969 with the registration number SC047007.
