Carron United Presbyterian Church (1878-1900) Carron United Free Church (1900-1929)

Carron United Presbyterian Church was formed in 1878 and formally established in 1879 by a petition to Falkirk Presbytery of the United Presbyterian Church by members of Falkirk Erskine UP Church who lived in Carron. The congregation met in Carron schoolroom until a new building was opened in 1881. The congregation entered the United Free Church in 1900 and the Church of Scotland in 1929. In 1963 the congregation was united with Stenhouse Parish Church to form Stenhouse & Carron Parish Church.

The Church of Scotland kirk session for Carron sat within the Presbytery of Linlithgow and Falkirk. In 1976 it became part of the presbytery of Falkirk.

The Carron church building was erected in 1881 and demolished in 1996.
