Cumbernauld Baird Church finding aid

Cumbernauld United Presbyterian Church Cumbernauld Baird United Free Church

Cumbernauld anti-burgher congregation was formed in the 1750s by a secession from the Original Secession congregation of Cumbernauld (see Cumbernauld Bridgend). In 1820 it joined the United Secession church and in 1847 it joined the United Presbyterian church. In 1900 it entered the United Free Church as Cumbernauld - Baird United Free. In 1920 it united with Bridgend United Free Church as Cumbernauld United Free Church, which entered the Church of Scotland in 1929, taking the name Cumbernauld St Andrew's.

In 1952 it united with Cumbernauld - St Ninian's, and the newly united Church took the name Cumbernauld Parish Church (and later Cumbernauld Old).
