Falkirk Bainsford began as a small house church in Granary Square with Rev E M Rate. The congregation moved to Old Bainsford School, Union St and then to the Old Barn in Main St. By 1871, they had built the North End Mission Hall and formed the Free Church congregation, calling their first minister in 1878. The congregation entered the United Free Church in 1900 and entered the Church of Scotland in 1929.

The first Ministers of this congregation were: Rev Alex Paterson, 1878-1890, Rev C J T Merrylees, 1890-1901, Rev D M Munro, 1901-1906, and Rev H M Ross, 1907-
