Falkirk Camelon Irving Memorial Church finding aid

Camelon Irving Memorial Church was established in 1872 as a Free Church Mission, run by Falkirk Free Church, before becoming a Free Church charge in its own right in 1890. The congregation entered the United Free Church in 1900 and in 1906 adopted the name Irving Memorial Church, after the Rev Lewis Hay Irving, first minister of Falkirk Free Church. The congregation entered the Church of Scotland in 1929. The congregation united with Camelon St John's Parish Church in December 2003 and the new united congregation took the name Camelon Parish Church.

The building on Dorrator Road, Camelon was erected in 1890.
