#### Slamannan Balquhatstone Church finding aid

##### Slamannan Free Church Slamannan United Free Church

Balquhatstone Church was a congregation of the Free Church of Scotland, entered the United Free Church in 1900 and the Church of Scotland in 1929. It was united with Slamannan St Laurence on 25 October 1945 to form Slamannan Parish Church.

The Church of Scotland kirk session for Balquhatstone sat in the presbytery of Linlithgow and Falkirk and from 1976 in the presbytery of Falkirk.

The congregation met at Pirnie Hill from 1844-1861 and then moved to building on Station Road in 1861.
