Forbes of Callendar Papers finding aid Part 10 – Earlstoun Estates

This collection consists of 36m of records from 1531-1974. The records have been arranged into twenty eight series (see next page for details) and the finding aid has been separated into these series to make it easier to download from our website

Part 10 contains papers relating to the estate of Earlstoun and related lands in the stewartry of Kirkcudbright and sheriffdom of Dumfries, 1747-1867. These include some papers relating to the local administration of the Stewartry of Kirkcudbright.
