Falkirk Labour Party finding aid

The Labour Party was set up in 1900 as the Labour Representation Committee. The policy of this organisation which became the Labour Party was one of class collaboration. In 1906 when the Labour Party proper was formed it embraced “a readiness to cooperate with any party which for the time being may be engaged in promoting legislation in the direct interest of Labour.”
