National Association of Local Government Officers (NALGO) finding aid (East Stirlingshire, Falkirk & Grangemouth Branches)

NALGO was a trades union, affiliated to the Scottish Trades Union Congress. The first branch of NALGO was set up in Dundee in 1912 and a mass meeting in Glasgow in 1919 led to the national establishment of the union. In 1993 NALGO amalgamated with two other local government unions to form Unison.
