National Union of Foundry Workers of Great Britain and Ireland finding aid

The National Union of Foundry Workers of Great Britain and Ireland was established at Manchester in 1920 with the amalgamation of the Friendly Society of Ironfounders of England, Ireland and Wales, (established 1809), the Associated Ironmoulders of Scotland (established 1831) and the Amalgamated Society of Coremakers (established 1860). It became part of the Amalgamated Union of Foundry Workers in 1946.
