

Kinneil Park

Brush up on local history at Kinneil

Length: 1.7km

Duration: 30 mins - 1 hour

For this challenge, head outside with family and friends or take this challenge on solo. Either way, by the end you'll be well on your way to 'expert' status. This walk along National Cycle Route 76 is a great opportunity to think about the things you enjoy and take a moment to appreciate them. Start in the woodland car park off Provost Road. Once you pass round the big metal gate head uphill to the left. After a hundred metres you'll find two gateposts in the middle of nowhere.
