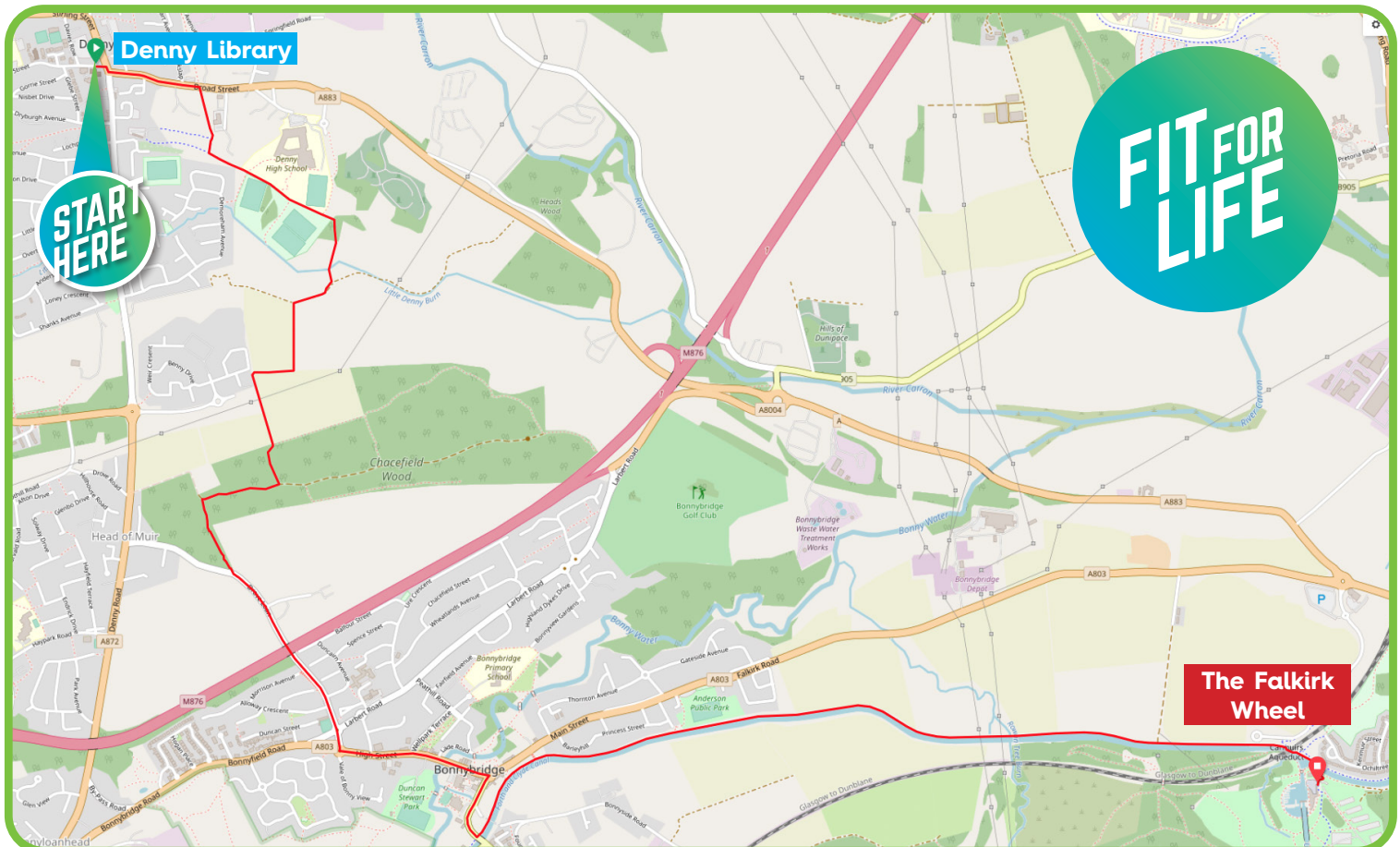


Cycle route

Denny Library to The Falkirk Wheel Length: 4.7 miles

Pick up a Forth Bike at the Denny Library. Head 350 yards down Broad street and turn right at the set of lights, onto the cycle and walking path. Head straight along this path and to the left, passing the Denny High School to your left. Once past the school and the associated playing fields, turn right and head south across the Little Denny Burn, these paths are a bit rough - so please watch yourselves. Once you rejoin a larger country road, take the first left and keep heading south. Turn right at the end of that lane and left again, heading into Chacefield Wood. Once in the woods, take a right at the junction, and then a left, which will help you eventually rejoin Drove Loan. Head straight down Drove Loan for half a mile, and turn left at the High Street roundabout. Proceed into Bonnybridge, and turn right on Bridge Street, and turn left onto the Forth & Clyde Towpath. Once on the Towpath, cycle straight along for 2 miles until you spot the Falkirk Wheel on the opposite side of the Canal. Cross the bridge, enter the site and drop off your Forth Bike into the docking station by the entrance to the Visitor Centre. For more details please visit www.falkirkactivetravelhub.org
